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TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE GDPR IN HEALTH NEWSLETTER SERVICE As of day May 15, 2022

§ 1. [GENERAL PROVISIONS]

1. These Terms and Conditions of the Newsletter Service, hereinafter referred to as the "Terms and Conditions", set forth the rules for the provision of content by e-mail (hereinafter referred to as the "Newsletter Service") by the Operator of the Service.
2. The Operator of the Service is wZdrowiu Limited Liability Company, with its registered office in Warsaw, at Żelazna St., No. 59, apt. 1405, 00-848, post office Warsaw, having NIP 5272989565, REGON: 52126137800000, entered in the Register of Entrepreneurs, KRS 0000953569.
3. In order to use the Newsletter service, it is necessary to have access to the Internet and to have an electronic mail address (e-mail), while it is not necessary to meet any special technical requirements other than having a standard operating system and a standard web browser.

§ 2. [SERVICE SUBJECT MATTER]

1. The Newsletter Service consists of sending by the Operator of the Service to the electronic mail address (e-mail) provided by the User messages containing educational and promotional information, in particular information on events and projects aimed at raising the competence of employees in the health care sector in relation to GDPR regulations and cyber security, including the dispatch of conference materials on the conference indicated on the website <http://www.rodowzdrowiu.pl/> by the personal data administrator /service provider / conference organizer wZdrowiu Limited Liability Company (Żelazna 59/1405, 00-848 Warsaw).
2. The User, by concluding an agreement for the Newsletter service with the Service Operator, shall make available his/her name, electronic mail address (e-mail), position and represented entity, provided in the Newsletter form, for the purpose of receiving messages referred to in paragraph 1 above.
3. The Newsletter service shall commence upon the conclusion of the Newsletter service agreement.

§ 3. [TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE]

1. The Newsletter service is free of charge.
2. The Newsletter service may be used by any person who, on the website in the domain www.rodowzdrowiu.pl or any other domain that allows signing up for the Newsletter,

provides his/her name, e-mail address, represented entity and position in the sign-up form and then clicks the "Register" button. Clicking the indicated button sends the provided personal data to the Service Operator and starts the Newsletter service provision.

3. When using the Newsletter service, the user is obliged to refrain from providing content of an unlawful nature, in particular in terms of providing someone else's data without the consent of authorized persons.
4. Particular messages, sent within the Newsletter service, constitute works within the meaning of the copyright law and are subject to protection specified by the law. Any copying, modification and use in a manner inconsistent with its purpose or without the consent of the Operator of the Service may constitute a violation of the law.

§ 4. [DURATION OF THE SERVICE]

1. The Newsletter Service Agreement is concluded for an indefinite period of time.
2. The user has the right to terminate the Newsletter service agreement. The termination shall have immediate effect.
3. The person using the Newsletter service shall terminate the agreement on the use of this service by sending a statement to this effect to the e-mail address: biuro@rodowzdrowiu.pl, by mail to the address of the Operator of the Service given in the provision of § 1 of the Regulations.
4. The Service Operator may suspend or terminate the Newsletter service after informing the User at the e-mail address provided by the User.
5. The Service Operator shall have the right to delete an invalid or non-existent e-mail address provided by the User.

§ 5. [PERSONAL DATA]

1. In matters relating to the processing of personal data submitted in the course of providing the Newsletter service, the provisions of the Privacy Policy, which constitutes Appendix No. 1 to the Regulations, shall apply..

§ 6. [CLAIMS]

1. Claims regarding the Newsletter service shall be submitted to the email address biuro@rodowzdrowiu.pl or by regular mail directly to the address of the Operator of the Service.
2. The complaint should include the data of the person making the complaint, necessary to send information about the outcome of the complaint, as well as a description of what the irregularities in the Newsletter service consisted of and what are the expectations for the resolution of the complaint.
3. The Service Provider shall consider the complaint within 14 days from the date of its receipt.

§ 7. [AMENDMENTS TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS]

1. The Service Provider reserves the right to amend the Terms and Conditions. Amendments to the Terms of Service shall come into force on the date specified with the information about the change, but not earlier than after 7 (seven) calendar days from the moment of informing about the changes to the Terms of Service, with the proviso that the amended Terms of Service shall be binding for the User, unless the User, within 7 (seven) days from the date of receiving the information about the change, declares resignation from the service in case of not accepting the new content of the Terms of Service. The User shall be notified each time the Regulations are amended to the electronic address provided by him/her in the Newsletter form.
2. Amendments to the Terms and Conditions of a technical or editorial nature shall not constitute an amendment to the Terms and Conditions.

Appendix 1 - Privacy Policy

In connection with the applicability of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC ("GDPR"), we provide below information about the Administrator's processing of your personal data.

ADMINISTRATOR OF USERS' PERSONAL DATA

1. The administrator of your personal data is wZdrowiu Limited Liability Company, with its registered office in Warsaw, at Żelazna St., No. 59, apt. 1405, 00-848, post office Warsaw, having NIP 5272989565, REGON: 52126137800000, entered in the Register of Entrepreneurs, KRS 0000953569 (hereinafter: Data Administrator).

3. Your personal data is processed by the Data Controller, on the basis of the consent given by you in connection with your wish to join the GDPR in Health Newsletter.
4. Provision of data is voluntary, however, failure to provide such data will make it impossible to join the GDPR in Health Newsletter and to transmit messages containing educational and promotional information, in particular information on events and projects aimed at raising the competence of health sector employees with regard to GDPR regulations and cyber security, including the dispatch of conference materials regarding the conference indicated on <http://www.rodowzdrowiu.pl/> by the personal data administrator /service provider / conference organizer wZdrowiu Limited Liability Company (Żelazna 59/1405, 00-848 Warsaw).
5. The scope of your personal data processed by the Administrator includes: your name, e-mail address, the name of the position held and the entity represented.
6. Your personal data are processed for the period of service, until you withdraw your consent to receive the Newsletter. Thereafter, the Administrator may store them until the statute of limitations on claims.
7. You have the right of access to your data and the right to request their rectification, erasure or restriction of their processing, the right to object to processing, and the right to data portability.
8. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the data protection supervisory authority in the Member State of your habitual residence, place of work or the place where the alleged breach was committed.
9. Your personal data may be transferred to entities with which contracts have been concluded for the entrustment of the processing of personal data, as well as to persons and entities at their legitimate request, in accordance with applicable data protection regulations.
10. Your data will not be transferred to a third country.
11. Your data will not be subject to processes involving automated decision-making, including profiling.
